

## THE UCSIA GUEST HOUSE

Brand-new, [UCSIA's Guest House](#) was opened in the spring of 2008. It is a functional, fully-equipped, quiet and comfortable house, ideally located in the historic centre of town and just opposite the main entrance of the University of Antwerp's city campus. .

### Requirements

- a maximum of one guest or one guest and a partner
- a minimum rent of 6 weeks
  - \* monthly rent: consult [www.ucsia.org/guesthouse](http://www.ucsia.org/guesthouse)
- the purpose of the stay should be directly related to higher education, scientific research or other higher education-based services to society
- refundable deposit equivalent to 2 weeks rent
- no smoking


The City Campus of the University of Antwerp is home to all the departments and research groups involved in the humanities and liberal arts.

All other campuses of the University of Antwerp, the Hogeschool Antwerpen, the Karel De Grote-Hogeschool, the Hogere Zeevaartschool and the Plantijnhogeschool can easily be reached on foot or by public transport.

[The Guest House](#) is a 15 minute walk from the central railway station as well as a 15 minute walk from the historic market square, the river Scheldt and the Cathedral of Our Lady, Antwerp.

A full range of retail shops, supermarkets, restaurants, pharmacies and doctors can be found in the immediate vicinity of the Guest House. During the academic year and when classes finish the streets can be full of students, yet the overall atmosphere is quiet and safe with little traffic.



**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The University Centre Saint-Ignatius Antwerp (UCSIA) is an independent, non-profit organisation founded by the Jesuit Order and members of the former university institution UFSIA.

UFSIA as well as the former UIA and RUCA have been integrated into the University of Antwerp which upholds the principle of active pluralism.

The University of Antwerp and four schools for higher education (Hogere Zeevaartschool, Artesis-Hogeschool Antwerpen, Karel de Grote-Hogeschool and Plantijnhogeschool) between them constitute the Antwerp Association.

UCSIA complements the main tasks of the University of Antwerp (research, education and services to science and society) through a wide range of activities such as academic conferences, workshops, teaching posts, scholarships, publications and public lectures. Its approach is multi-disciplinary and scholarly, leading to close cooperation with other national and international academic centres. Its Ignatian and Jesuit character are two other essential aspects of its mission and activity.

Since the activities of UCSIA lead to a constant flow of foreign visitors to Antwerp and the city campus of the University of Antwerp, many of them staying for a number of weeks or months, UCSIA has decided to acquire and thoroughly renovate a small guest house for the use of UCSIA, the University of Antwerp or the partners of the Antwerp Association.
